Method of payment



How to get to The Savill Garden

- The Savill Garden is a mile from Englefield Green and 4 miles from Windsor Castle. Approach via the A30 from the south and west, and by the A308 from the east and north. It is also close to the M25 (J13), M4 (J6) and M3
- The Savill Garden coach park is ONLY accessible from Wick Lane, and visitors from all directions should follow the brown tourist signs saying 'The Savill Garden' or depicting a flower symbol
- For sat navs, please use postcode TW20 0UJ to guide you to Wick Lane and the coach entrance to The Savill Garden



All information correct at time of print in January 2017 however, we would always recommend you please check before travelling for any date specific events.

Accessibility

- The Savill Building and The Savill Garden offer good accessibility for disabled visitors
- There is a flat level walk from the coach park to The Savill Building
- Non-motorised wheelchairs are available on a first come, first served basis
- Assistance dogs are welcome to all parts of Windsor Great Park
- There are good all weather paths around The Savill Garden, allowing access for wheelchair users
- The garden has some slight inclines and dips, we therefore suggest that there are some sections of the garden that may require an able bodied carer to assist when using a non-motorised wheelchair
- A carer accompanying a disabled visitor enjoys free entry into The Savill Garden






Why people love The Savill Garden...

Autumn is a wonderful time in the Garden, with later flowering Dahlias, Salvias and the delights in the sub-tropical garden, combining with golden grasses, and the changing hues of our glorious Japanese Maples.



Our Royal history

The Savill Garden was created by Sir Eric Savill, grand master of the woodland garden, in the 1930s with the support of King George V and Queen Mary. Since that time, the Garden has continued to develop under Royal Patronage, with most recently H.M. the Queen opening the Rose Garden.
