Windsor Farm Shop – Duke’s Afternoon

On a Royal visit to Ceylon in 1954, H.R.H. The Prince Philip, Duke of Edinburgh, was invited to plant a bush on the renowned Lovers Leap estate in Nuwara Eliya, the ‘Champagne’ region of tea. Harvested from that very estate, Lovers Leap is cherished by connoisseurs for its distinctive character. Delicate and gentle, it offers a golden glow and a mild green finish.

The following selection of loose leaf teas have been sourced from Birchall. Birchall produce carbon-neutral tea from their solar-powered factory in Wiltshire. Teas are Fairtrade and sourced from Rainforest Alliance Certified farms.

Great Rift breakfast blend – Decaffeinated is also available

Crafted using the finest teas from across East Africa. Great Rift has an unrivalled bright and brilliant taste, which has made it the UK’s most awarded tea, winning a prestigious Great Taste Award for a record 13 consecutive years.

Virunga Earl Grey tea

A scented pure origin tea, sourced from the finest tea gardens in Rwanda. It is blended with a traditional bergamot oil to give a distinctive flavour of citrus, with spicy floral notes.

Lapsang souchong

A venerable black tea from China with a distinctive, smoky taste and aroma – the unique result of drying tea leaves over pinewood fires. It is a traditional British favourite, perfect in the afternoon.

Darjeeling

A beautifully delicate whole leaf tea, grown high in the Himalayan foothills and often celebrated as the ‘Champagne of Teas’.

Virunga chai

Virunga chai infuses the brightness and vitality of a supreme African black tea, with red rooibos from South Africa and an eclectic blend of herbs and spices.

Oolong

Single origin Formosa Oolong is grown high up in the mountains of Taiwan. It produces a fresh, light and delicate liquor.

Green tea

Mao Feng is a pure green tea sourced from China where the very best green teas are found. This cleansing whole leaf green tea brightens up when infused, producing a smooth fragrant taste.

Peppermint

A classic herbal tea made from only the finest pure peppermint leaves.

Camomile

A classic herbal tea made from the scented flowers and leaves of the wild camomile plant.

Lemongrass and ginger

A warming herbal tea made from pure lemongrass and spicy ginger pieces.

Red berry and flower

A luxuriously smooth blend of sweet red berries and refreshing hibiscus. This intense fruity combination perfectly balances the tart taste of blackcurrants with real juicy strawberry pieces. A lovely refreshing infusion that’s always caffeine-free.
